# **Ministry Activities**

#### **Individual Discipling Relationships**

We engage in these relationships with teens who come to our events, as well as with others. We study the Bible and talk about life together. These relationships represent our most important work. We are also active in the life of a local church body.



### **Regular Youth Meetings**

These gatherings happen regularly throughout the school year. They are



designed to provide teens a community and a place to belong; and encourage them toward discipleship with Jesus. Meetings include music, Bible messages, fun games, food, and fellowship.

### Camps

Champs Camp is for children 6-12 years old. Youth Camp (summer and winter) is for teenagers. Children who started with us at Champs Camp now help with the camp as teenage volunteers. Many of them also now attend the Youth Camp. Some of these teens also are active in our youth meetings throughout the school year. Family Camp engages the families of these teens.

## **Spiritual Magazine for Teens**

This magazine is published quarterly. It presents Biblical truths, as well as encouraging articles. It includes reviews of music and movies from a spiritual perspective, as well as interviews with teens with whom we work.



#### Youth Band

The band is another way to creatively engage with teens. Rehearsals include a brief Bible message or devotional thought that connects with the music.



# Seminars for Parents and Churches

Along with invited guest speakers, we engage with

parents in dialogue, and by providing them strategies and counsel for parenting and family life, from a Biblical perspective. We also offer churches seminars in mentoring and discipling young people.
